

TRANSPORTS IN LISBON

There are two fare zones for Lisbon's **METRO**, but all of the main tourist areas and the airport are within zone 1. The 2018 Lisbon metro fare prices are:

- €1.45 Single Fare
- €6.15 24-hour unlimited travel, which includes all Lisbon bus and trams.


Note: There are no return tickets, but multiple single tickets can be purchased for return journeys.

The fare is charged to the reusable "Viva Viagem" card, which costs €0.50 for the initial purchase. This card can be used to store a range of metro tickets including multiple single fares, the 24-hour pass or the "Zapping" credit.

Note: Each passenger requires their own Viva Viagem ticket.

METRO MAP










PUBLIC TRANSPORTS BETWEEN THE AIRPORT AND THE HOTEL IMPERADOR:

Reaching the hotel is very easy: exit from the arrivals zone, on the right you will find the metro station, catch the red line in the one and only possible direction (São Sebastião) and exit at Saldanha station. Walk a few meters and there you are!









TAXI:

The taxis in Lisbon are surprisingly good value for travelling around the city and are convenient for tired tourists or late-night revellers. Lisbon's taxis are painted a distinctive black and green colour (older taxis are cream coloured) and they can be hailed from the street or from specially marked bays.

In the majority of the tourist areas of Lisbon, taxis can be hailed from the street or are found waiting at taxi ranks. When a taxi needs to be called, Radio Taxis (Tel: 218119000, 969531660 or 919781000) is the largest company and have callers who speak English. An alternative company is Coop Taxis (Autocoope) (Tel: 217932756).

In Lisbon you can also use the following Apps: Cabify; Uber; Mytaxy; Chaffeur Privé

Electric scooters

One other easy way of getting around Lisbon, are electric scooters: download the app, assign a credit card and there you go (wear helmet!), without complications and burocracy. <u>Available apps/platforms in Lisbon: LIME; VOI scooters; Hive.</u> In some platforms you pay for "credits", in others you pay "as you go", so that you may prefer the latter if you are not using it at home.







TOURISTIC INFORMATION:

Cheerful, calm, and vibrant, Lisbon is a capital like no other. The city has a lot going on with events, exhibitions, <u>flea markets</u>, and shows scheduled practically around the clock, but it also offers a peaceful and relaxing environment where visitors can stroll off the beaten path and revel in nature or wind up in a historic neighbourhood where time seems to stand still.
